Annual Budget for 2025 Meeting

February 9, 2024, and Continued March 7, 2024

Chairman Gordy Reher called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM. Supervisor Colter Peterson, Supervisor Scott Wold and Treasurer Tim Mueller were in attendance.

The Board reviewed spending from past fiscal years and adjusted anticipated revenue and expenditures for the calendar year 2025. There were notable updates to costs and discussions on developing a new source of gravel for township use, road improvement projects and fire budget increases due to Longville needing a new fire truck.

More information is needed to finalize the budget for the suggested levy and the meeting will need to be continued at a later meeting to allow for more information.



The meeting was adjourned at 12:00 PM.


