Annual Budget for 2027 Meeting

February 13, 2026

Chairman Colter Peterson called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM. Supervisor Scott Wold, Supervisor Alex Haagensen and Treasurer Tim Mueller were in attendance.

The Board reviewed spending from past fiscal years and made minor adjustments across all funds to anticipated revenue and planned expenditures for the calendar year 2027. The gas tax and certificates of deposit (CD) did not influence these decisions.

The Board reviewed past decisions regarding the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and Capital Improvement Fund, which currently have no projects within the Plan at this time. But further discussions will take place this year to identify future road projects to add to the CIP. A CD of \$150K was opened in January 2026 to put aside reserves from the increased levy that took place in 2025.

The General fund levy proposed at \$195,956 for 2027, no change from 2026.


Discussion on budgeting for Road & Bridge funds brought up categories of paved vs unpaved streets, ice and snow removal, road surveys, chloride, and weed control. This Road & Bridge fund will request to increase levy in 2027 to \$208,337, an increase of \$3,337 from 2026.

Fire fund was reviewed noting annual increases of 3% for Hackensack Fire and expected increases with Longville Fire also. This Fire fund will request to increase levy in 2027 to \$130,682, an increase of \$682 from 2026.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:20 PM.
