Clerk's Report –

1. Effective January 1, 2026 a new Minnesota Paid Leave Law. Minn. Stat. Ch. 268B requires employers, including townships to participate. In January there was a M/S/P from Wold/Peterson that Woodrow Township will contribute 100% of the total Paid Leave premium required for each eligible employee. Clerk Dietrich received guidance a Resolution should be created to establish specific policy for compliance, premium sharing and administration.

M/S/P Wold/Peterson Woodrow Township by Resolution will contribute 100% of the total Paid Leave premium required for each eligible employee. Town Clerk will administer this with payroll.

1. Supervisor Wold presented the Cass County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) storm water runoff plan for Edgewater Dr. The plan includes a larger culvert, regrading of area, rearrangement of riprap and more to handle 2-inch rain event in a 24-hr. period. The preliminary engineering plan is estimated at \$43K and the estimated township cost share is estimated at 10%. The township will be provided with the final plan cost at the March monthly meeting. Supervisors Peterson and Haagensen have no objections to keeping the project moving forward.


