**REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES**

Clerk's Report –

2026 Annual meeting went well; meeting minutes nearly complete and will be posted to website once complete.

**OPEN FORUM**

- Lloyd Thielman praised the annual meeting and thanked whoever responded to his road condition concern, it was fixed quickly.

**OLD BUSINESS**

1. Supervisor Wold provided an update on the Cass County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) storm water runoff plan for Edgewater Dr. The plan includes a larger culvert, regrading of area, rearrangement of riprap and more to handle 2-inch rain event in a 24-hr. period. The engineering plan cost is \$42,235.50 and the estimated township cost share is estimated at 10%. The funding source for the project is from state watershed funds specifically Leech Lake River watershed monitoring.

M/S/P Wold/Peterson Approve cost share agreement and authorize up to \$5,000 for engineering project costs.

Neighboring landowners are considering vacating that portion of the public road and if approved, the township requires a drainage easement and maintenance access to protect the investment. The landowners are fine with the easement, and their main concern is securing it as private property.

**Supervisor Peterson –**

**Supervisor Wold –**

- Buxton watershed preliminary plan was reviewed, and the cost comes from the same funding source as Edgewater Dr. There is a plan to include paving a portion of the road due to the steep hills. The engineering plan that was done includes only the stormwater not the paving. The project is estimated at \$80K and SWCD continues to fine tune the project design. The township has not committed to this project at this time and will be discussed in a future meeting.
