- Citizen Larson mentioned that the AED battery will need to be replaced April 1st, 2027, and are currently ~\$120-\$300 depending on battery.
- Citizen Hage asked in general if people are happy with better coverage since new cell tower was installed on Buxton. Supervisors haven't heard anything about whether there is better coverage or not. Supervisor Wold commented that TDS is adding fiber going east on Hwy 5 from Co Rd 11. Last summer TDS added fiber going west on Hwy 5 from Co Rd 11.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

Supervisor Peterson –

- Nothing to report.

Supervisor Wold –

- Citizen Hage raised the concern that it would be nice to have a five Supervisor Board and provided information to Supervisor Wold. Any change from a three to five Supervisor Board would need to be decided by the electors at the Annual Meeting. Citizen Hage stated it would improve continuity when a supervisor is absent and mentioned that there was one Supervisor at the Annual Meeting. Supervisors noted that the Annual meeting is not a supervisor run meeting and is optional for supervisors to attend.

A few concerns were raised by other citizens in attendance, candidate availability, and not enough work available plus cost of two additional supervisors on board could raise the annual levy.

This subject will need to be raised by the citizens for the 2027 annual meeting as the board does not create the annual meeting agenda.

Supervisor Haagensen –

- Buxton winter maintenance issues were reported, road has humps making plowing difficult, turnaround area not always fully cleared and light snowfalls (2–3 inches) typically not plowed per policy.
