What do I need to know and how do I start planning?

Cass County's major hazard threats are;

- Summer storms wind, tornado, and flood.
- Winter storms wind, blizzard, snow, and cold.
- Wildfire can have multiple effects.
- Medical Personal injury or illness.
- Electrical outage from storms even in winter.

Focus on What You Do Best — taking care of FAMILY!

You will need to keep the following and easily accessible (i.e. note on fridge):

- 2 Local and 2 Non-Local Emergency Contacts, include Name, address, phone, and email
- Doctor name and phone
- List of medications for each person and what they are for.

1 week supplies to keep in your home

- Medication
- l gallon water/person/day
- Non-perishable foods that require minimal prep
- > A first aid kit
- Anything else your family will need to survive
- 2 sets of clothing, boots, coat, gloves, mittens, and hat
- Toilet kit (i.e. camping self-contained or pail with liner) and don't forget toilet paper and sanitizer!

Identify your SAFE SPACE — Basement or storm cellar, interior hallway or closet. Roof if flooding occurs. Be prepared for ANY disaster and know your SAFE SPACE!
